Player and Family Information Form

So that we can ensure you and your player receive all communications and updated information from the Booster Club, we kindly ask that you submit a brief *Player and Family Information Form*. This form is distributed and collected at the first parent meeting or during the first week of practice.

Uniform Socks

The Athletic Department and coaches handle uniform assignment and distribution, but the Booster Club purchases two pairs of socks (one white, one maroon) for each player. Socks are distributed to players at practice.

Game Schedules and Communications

The Athletic Department is responsible for scheduling all games and updating the Arbiter Live website with any changes. Schedule changes are communicated directly to coaches, so they are the best source for most updated information. <https://www.arbiterlive.com/Teams?entityId=20945>

Meals for Away Games

The Booster Club organizes the optional purchase and delivery of meals for players to eat on the bus after away games. The meals consist of a sandwich, fruit or veggie, chips or cookie, and drink. Parents/Guardians will receive an order form once the final roster is established for the season.

Spirit Wear

The Booster Club organizes a spirit wear sale through Creative Engraving & Apparel prior to the season start. The sale dates and weblink for ordering will be sent via email and posted on the Booster Club website (shipsoccerboosters.org).

Concession Stand

Due to the minimal profit and uncertainty of volunteers, availability of concessions at middle school home games for the 2023 season is to be determined. **Please reach out to an officer if this is of interest to you!**

End of Season Banquet

The Booster Club plans and hosts an end of season informal “banquet” – typically a picnic at a local park – to celebrate the end of the season and honor the players and coaches. More information will be provided.

Primary Fundraiser

Having two food stands at the Shippensburg Fair eliminates the need for our soccer players and families to duplicate fundraisers of other teams or schools. It does require a lot of planning and volunteer workers, though. All players and parents/guardians are needed for at least one shift. Please save the dates (see reverse side) and watch for more information in late spring.

Booster Club Funds

The activity fee required of athletes is collected by the Athletic Department. The Booster Club does not receive a portion of that fee, nor are families asked to pay a booster club fee. All donations and funds raised by the Shippensburg Soccer Booster Club are used to carry out its mission. Financial transparency is visible in the treasurer’s reports reviewed at monthly meetings and summarized in minutes posted on the website.
