Meeting Minutes

April 10, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM by President Rhonda Gladfelter.

Old Business:

- **Away Game Meals:**
 - Rhonda reported that three players did not turn in their away game meal order form by the deadline and then later tried to order.
- **Middle School Soccer:**
 - The season got off to a rough start mainly due to the weather.
 - Rhonda needs volunteers to sell spirit wear at the home games. She is looking to sell at one girl's game and one boy's game. Niki Estep previously told Rhonda that she would volunteer to sell at a girls game. Joette offered to help Niki sell at the home game on the 20th. Scarlet offered to help at the home game on the 13th after half-time.
 - Rhonda is going to email out pictures of what spirit wear is still available and offer a cash & carry.

New Business:

- Jan Nye's mother recently passed away. The board had a planter sent to her from our Booster Club, the coaches and players.
- **Community Night:**
 - Community Night will be held on August 18th, 2017. The first day of school is August 17th. Each of the booster clubs can have a stand set up at Community Night. Rhonda stated that she would like to sell spirit wear and walking tacos.
 - Stacy Shank stated that she has some large kitchen pans that we can use.
 - Jen Clough suggested selling freezer pops.

- Memorial Park Concession Stand:
 - Rhonda reported that she received an email from Michael Montedoro asking if our booster club would be interested in running the concession stand during the home football games. She doesn't have any other details. The idea is that the soccer booster club would run the stand during the home football games and the football booster club would run the stand during the home soccer games. Adele asked if we would still be the parking during the football games as well. Joette said she will follow-up with the physical therapy place on that.

- Website:
 - Rhonda reported that she has some changes that she would like to have made to the website, like putting up a link to Sign-Up Genius.
 - She needs to get the Middle School soccer to Adele so it can be updated on the website.
 - Adele reported that she can try to get the website linked to the booster club's Facebook page. Scarlet reported that she is an administrator for the Facebook page as well as Adele, Joette and Rhonda.

- Middle School Banquet:
 - The last soccer game is May 19th. The last day of school is May 26th. Rhonda will see if we can get the high school cafeteria for May 22nd or May 23rd to have the Middle School banquet/pizza party.

- Fair Stand:
 - Rhonda reported that she would like to start scheduling times to work on making repairs & improvements to the fair stand (prior to fair week). She will get a list of dates together to email to everyone for cleaning and painting.
 - Stacy stated that she can get grease remover to be used to remove the grease off of the hot-side floor.
 - The board discussed what we could give to the players as incentives for coming to help. It was suggested to get coupons for Rita's, Goose Brothers, Cabin on King, etc.

- Soccer Camp:
 - Joette stated that she would like to do fundraisers to help raise money to pay for the kids going to soccer camp. This would have to be separate from the booster club and would not be a booster club function. There are 14 boys signed up for camp.
