Meeting Minutes

March 13, 2017

In Attendance: Rhonda Gladfelter, Kim Taylor, Adele Kirby, Becky Cramer, Jill Hubbard, and Michelle Holtry.

The meeting was called to order at 7:01 PM by President Rhonda Gladfelter.

The February meeting minutes were reviewed and approved on a motion made by Jill Hubbard and seconded by Kim Taylor. Motion carries.

The Treasurer's report was reviewed and approved on a motion made by Adele Kirby and seconded by Jill Hubbard. Motion carries.

Old Business:

- Middle School Soccer:
 - Rhonda reported that she is working on getting the packets together to hand out to the players.

- Away Game Meals:
 - Rhonda reported that we are going to go with the school cafeteria for the away games this season. Joette and Rhonda met with Jared from Chartwells. The meal includes a 6" sub (turkey or ham), the kids will choose the type of cheese and condiments, a piece of fruit, a bag of baked chips, a cookie and a gatorade. The cost is \$7.50 per meal.
 - Jared will create the form for the kids to fill out for their order choices. Each player will get a bag with their name on it that contains their meal.
 - Jared will be the one to contact the office if he thinks a game may be cancelled.

- Middle School Banquet:
 - We are going to try to have this year's middle school banquet at the high school cafeteria. The Booster Club will provide the pizza.
 - The boys team players can each bring a dessert
 - The girls team players can each bring drinks.
 - Rhonda will call the school to check the schedule and book the cafeteria.

- Fair Stand Update:
 - Rhonda received the quote for the serving doors for the fair stand. They will be maroon in color. The estimate is from Cumberland Garage Doors. The quote also includes pouring the concrete out back and between the fair stands. The rough estimate for everything is \$7400.00 which is very reasonable. The

estimate does not include the discount that Mike Coy wants to give us. The labor portion of the estimate is only \$250.00.

- The concrete part of the estimate is \$1500.00. The Booster Club will pay for that out of our budget.
- We also need new pedestrian doors.
- Rhonda reported that she will start to get Sign-Up Genius going for the fair stand schedule.
- The board discussed if we should continue to use the same vendors as we have in the past. The board agreed to go with the same vendors for the pies, rolls, and cake.
- The kegerator leaks and needs to be fixed. The bottom is rusted. Rhonda wants Adele to coordinate the repairs with the man that handles the kegerator.
- The board discussed the manager on duty. Adele volunteered to take the MOD shift from 8am to 4pm on Thursday and Friday. Jill Hubbard will do Friday from 3pm-11pm. Rhonda will ask Kim Weikel, Lisa Souders, Angie Barmont, and Jen VanHorne.

New Business:

- Uniforms:
 - Kim Taylor asked if the board thought if we should go through the uniforms to see what needs to be replaced. The school is to purchase the uniforms.
 - It was agreed that Coach Jones should approach the school now for replacing high school uniforms for the fall season.
- Fair:
 - Rhonda reported that at the next monthly meeting we will review our charts of supplies for the food for the fair stand.
 - We will also need to see what items we need to get donated.
 - We also need to get up in the attic to see what is up there.
