

## Shippensburg Soccer Booster Club

Meeting Minutes

May 9, 2016

In Attendance: Rhonda Gladfelter, Joette Shetter, Mary Eutzy, Jen VanHorn, Scarlett Gettel, Marc Hagemeyer, Sam Foore, Becky Cramer and Jen Clough.

The meeting was called to order at 7:01 PM by President Rhonda Gladfelter.

The meeting minutes from April 2016 were approved on a motion made by Jen VanHorn and seconded by Scarlett Gettel. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's Report was presented noting a deposit and the payment for the subs for the away games. The Treasurer's Report was approved on a motion made by Jen VanHorn and seconded by Marc Hagemeyer. Motion carried.

Open Issues:

- Restaurant Fundraisers: Scarlett Gettel contacted Rita's Italian Ice. They are to return her call. Jen VanHorn suggested contacting Chipotle. They donate 50% of the proceeds. Joette Shetter and Mary Eutzy reported that the All Night Party committee did a fundraiser with Arooga's and made \$266. It is only done on Monday & Tuesdays. Scarlette added that Cabin on King does these fundraisers as well.
- Away Game Meals from Subway: There has been good feedback from the kids on the Subway meals. The pick ups for the boy's team were all taken care of. A few of the girls games didn't have a pick up person. Buffy Henry volunteered to pick up for the remaining. It was also reported that there was no ice on the drinks at the boys away games. This will be mentioned to Rita at Subway at the meeting. Mary Eutzy suggested getting the subs from Maple Wood for the boys in the fall. There is some concern that a six inch sub is not going to be enough food for the high school boys and girls. Maple Wood have said that they can accommodate us.
- Storage Shed: Rhonda reported that Warren Jones and Mike Montedoro will carry out any further business to do with the shed.
- Community Night: Tim Hess was contacted regarding community night. He will be back to us about the regulations with the park as to what food we can sell.
- Spirit Wear: Rhonda presented some designs from a website. There will be a vote at the banquet on the design. Orders will be done so we have extra to sell at community night, home games etc.

- Meeting Places: A new meeting place for the June meeting needs to be determined since school will be closed for the summer. During July the meetings are held at the fair stand. In August Rhonda will submit the requests to hold the meetings at the school. Those present discussed other venues as options. Knutes was highly suggested again. Rhonda will also check on University Grille and CJ's. She will also check into holding the meetings at her church.
  
- Fair Stand:
  - Rhonda setup Sign Up Genius for the fair stand schedule. More emails need to be updated in the Sign Up Genius. Some people have already started signing up. It seems to be working well.
  
  - Training will be needed from Brendan West and Joette Shetter for the managers on duty. They both attended the food prep safety course offered by the VFW. An email will be sent to the coaches for them to have a day of the week in which they are responsible to complete any open slots. Monday July 11th will be the night that the girls' teams to be at the fair stand to help clean and set up. Monday July 18th will be the boys' teams night to do the same. Pizza, chips and soda will be offered those nights for those who come to help.
  
  - Rhonda reported that Brendan West contacted her to set up another meeting in May to discuss the fair stand. June 1st was suggested and Rhonda will see if that works for Brendan.
  
  - Soup, coffee floats and doughnuts have been taken off of the menu. It was suggested to add dill pickles on a stick to the menu.
  
  - Selling ads for the fair stand was discussed. The question is how to preserve the ads on the counter tops.
  
- The Middle School teams banquet will be held at the middle school on May 24th. The booster club will pay for the players' meals. The families will have to pay for their meals. The booster club will purchase the chicken, paper products and drinks. The players are asked to bring a covered dish as follows: 7th grade = desserts, 8th & 9th grade = hot or cold sides. Four coach gifts will be purchased at a cost of \$18 each. Gifts for the players were discussed. It was suggested to give socks to the underclassmen as gifts.

- There are no updates from coaches since none are present at this meeting.
