

Shippensburg Soccer Booster Club Minutes

February 8, 2021

Present: Matt Lane, Angie Fogelsonger, Jason Henry, Jill Hubbard

Call to order: 7:00 PM

President Jason Henry opened the meeting with explanation that the email groups did not send correctly. Therefore, many parents did not receive the email giving meeting information. This will be rectified prior to any other mass announcements that need to be made, and the Facebook permissions will be obtained so that information can be shared there as well. Jill Hubbard will contact Scarlett Gettel to ask for administrator permissions on the booster fb page.

Review of Minutes: Jason Henry reminded that the November 2020 meeting was mainly about the high school end-of-season banquet plans and voting on new officers.

Treasurer's report: Chris Saboe was unable to attend the meeting. The following is from an email he sent to Jason Henry and Jill Hubbard.

"The bank account transfer is happening slowly. Jason and I have one more step in the process to sign off on the transfer of the account. We both expect to sign this paper work this week. Once complete, I will meet with Becky Cramer to review responsibilities, transfer the monthly tasks and receive any remaining documents.

I have received General Ledger books from 2018, 2019 and 2020. The books have been balanced 1/1/2018 to 10/31/2020 by Debra A. Ramsey. We have a signed letter acknowledging the books are true and accurate.

I have not received any bank statements at this time. Based on a checking transaction report we have an estimated \$8,742.80 in the account. The account balance will be confirmed after the transfer is complete."

Middle School season: All coaches have agreed to using Amber's Country Catering for the away meals for the middle school players (per email to Coach Carey and Matt Lane's approval at this meeting). Team parents will be needed help with retrieving the coolers after the away games. One will be needed for the girls' teams and one for boys' teams.

Coach Carey and Coach Lane both agreed that the same color compression long sleeve shirts should be made available for the players to purchase for cold weather games. The cost of this and the brand will be presented at the next meeting.

Jason Henry said that he would like the booster club to begin providing either the socks for the players or the compression shirts for them. The prices for these items will be presented at the March meeting to be further discussed.

Practices will begin the week of March 8th (per schedule emailed by Mike Montedoro to Coach Carey). The first game is scheduled for March 31, 2021. Packets for meals, socks, shirts, spirit wear and player and family information will be sent out via email during the week of March 8.

Fundraisers: Jason Henry suggested that we lessen the number of fundraisers to only a couple outside of the Fair fundraiser. He suggested BBQ chicken and car wash combined fundraiser twice a year.

Fair: Jason Henry said that the cold stand at the Fair would definitely need an electrician to fix light fixtures and switches. Tables will also need to either be built or purchased for the patio area. Jason Henry suggested we wait on specific Fair stand plans until we know whether the fair is going to happen. He is waiting on word for planning meetings by the Fair Committee.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 8:15.
