Call to order: Jason Henry called the meeting to order at 6:10 PM

President Jason Henry opened the meeting by reviewing the Minutes from the May10, 2021 meeting.

Treasurer's report: Chris Saboe shared the following: Current balance in booster account is \$8,082.27. Final check to Amber has not cleared, and the check for \$398.93 for the electrician was recently mailed. The Fair rental (\$40.00) will be paid this month.

Summer Team Camps and Summer leagues: The girls are currently playing in a summer league at Big Spring, and the boys will have their first game this week in Mechanicsburg. The boys have a tri-scrimmage scheduled for June 17.

High school warm up shirts for fall season: The seniors should have their design for the warm-up shirts finalized with Amy at Creative Engravings by August 10, 2021, so that there will be time to get them ordered once the rosters are finalized.

Fair: Jason and Chris attended the Fair meeting on June 9 and found out the following information:

- No masks are required at this point
- The licenses need to be updated- tax ID, Safe Serve, and food license
- Stands must be open each day from 11:00 am- 9:00 pm
- The large refrigerator will be available beginning on Friday 7/16
- The after fair meeting will be on 8/5 at the VFW
- There will be additional hand washing stations set up around the fair grounds

Michelle Holtry and Buffy Henry will be taking the Safe Serve training. Most food vendors have been contacted for deliveries for the fair. We are still waiting to hear from El Mariachi about cooking the ground beef for the taco dishes. We are also still comparing prices for the pulled pork. These decisions will be made within the next week and will be based on pricing. **Cleaning Day is scheduled for July 10, 2021 at 6:00 pm at the Fair stands.** An email will go out asking for help and for cleaning supplies to be brought, too.

Sign up Genius has been emailed to the parents of all soccer players. After the first week, the slots are approximately ¼ filled. The link will be emailed again in June.

Corn Festival: Jason Henry started the discussion about opening the fair stands for the Corn Festival in August. Because the boosters are helping with parking that day (and earning \$500.00 for that) it was decided not to open the stands that day. Six people are needed to help park cars that day from 9:30 am- 1:30 pm.
