### **High school season:**

- Boys' youth night will be on Monday, 9/27 at the stadium. Flyers will be sent to elementary schools and SSC. Look into a gift card for a raffle. We also have tshirts that we can raffle.
- The booster club is responsible for giving the senior the format for their bios for senior night.
- We will look into yard signs for the seniors.
- Ball runners for home games. We will send out a request to our soccer parents about siblings who would like to be ball runners.
- Waynesboro scrimmages for JV and Varsity boys on Saturday, August 21. Parents will be asked to volunteer food and drinks for this day.
- Northeastern tournament on September 4. All HS soccer teams will travel and play games that day. It will be a very long day for the players and coaches. We will organize 2 meals for the players and coaches that day. Parents will be asked to contribute.

- Away meals will still be from Amber. Those forms will be emailed to parents on 8/20/2021. The price is still \$5.80/meal.
- Selling concessions at home games will be discussed further at the next meeting.
