

## Shippensburg Soccer Booster Club Minutes

**Call to order:** Jason Henry called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. The meeting took place in the Beistle Pavilion at Southampton Park on Airport Rd.

President Jason Henry opened the meeting by reviewing the Minutes from the August meeting.

**Treasurer's report:** Chris was not able to attend. Jason shared that at the end of August, the checking account had \$14, 673.23, and the savings account had \$1, 103.16.

### **Fundraisers' Feedback:**

- Corn Fest parking raised \$1,000.00
- Football parking at Ship PT raised \$82.00 the first week. There are 4 more home football games.

### **High school season:**

- Boys' away meals from the West York game on 10/14 is now a home game so those meals will be used on Saturday, 9/25 at the Greencastle "tournament" games.
- Youth nights on 9/23 (girls') and 9/27 (boys')- tickets will be used for each youth attending who wears a jersey for 2 drawings each evening. A \$20 gift card and a Shippensburg soccer t-shirt will be given as prizes.
- Senior nights- The senior banners are being designed by Andrea Clugh. They will be ordered the week of 9/27. Flowers for senior nights (girls on 10/14 at SU and boys on 10/19 at Memorial Park) will be ordered from Fisher's Florist. Invitations for senior parents will be emailed in early October with the seniors' information to be read on senior night attached to the invitation email. Players will need to return his/her form to a booster officer by specific dates in order for them to be proofed. We still need someone to announce at the girls' game on 10/14.
- We are still looking for ball runners for the home games for both boys and girls.
- The yard signs for seniors have been ordered. Underclassmen will place these in the seniors' yards once they arrive.
- Soccer field signs and banners- Danielle Surotchak motioned to purchase field signs from Creative Engraving and Apparel. Becky Cramer seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous in approving these purchases.
- Food trucks could be arranged for home games. We also discussed selling Chik Fil A sandwiches, drinks, snacks and candy at the home games at the HS field. Becky will set up a table with snacks and drinks at the girls' home game on Tuesday, September 21.
- Discussions started regarding the HS banquet. We will have to wait until closer to the date to decide what venue (due to Covid) and what food. Options discussed were Living Faith Chapel, Britton Park, Tail Gate in a parking lot somewhere. This will be discussed more at the October meeting.
- Trophies will be provided by the VFW this year.
- Gifts for coaches and seniors were discussed. Jill will contact Amy Eckenrode for options. These will be discussed more at the October meeting.
