

## Shippensburg Soccer Booster Club

Meeting Minutes  
November 14, 2016

In Attendance: Rhonda Gladfelter, Joette Shetter, Kim Taylor, Adele Kirby, Sandra Pearson, Jennifer Clough, Becky Cramer, Lisa Souders, Angie Barmont, and Scarlett Gettel.

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 PM by President Rhonda Gladfelter.

The October meeting minutes were approved on a motion made by Lisa Souders and seconded by Sandra Pearson. Motion carries.

The Treasurer's Report was presented and reviewed as follows:

- We need to sell \$289 worth of spirit wear to make-up the total cost of the spirit wear. We have \$200 from the sale of the pink shirts to donate. Kim is waiting to hear back on how we can donate the money to pay for a mammogram for a local woman. There are still a lot of the pink cancer awareness shirts available to sell.
- The concessions made a net profit of \$400.01
- Manning the parking lot during the football games has brought in \$485.00. Joette spoke with the two owners of the physical therapy business where the parking lot is and they said it is okay for us to continue this next year as long as it is okay with the veterinarian's office. Kim stated that she goes to church with the veterinarian and she will have her mother-in-law approach him.
- We still have not received the bill for the shed.

The treasurer's report was approved on a motion made by Adele Kirby and seconded by Scarlett Gettel. Motion carries.

Old Items:

- Rhonda reported that Aaron King winterized the fair stand and taught Rick Gladfelter what should be done.

New Items:

- Election of Officers: The ballots were sent out prior and available on hand showing the following people running for the following board positions:

Nominations for the above listed positions were opened. No one in attendance wanted to be nominated nor did they want to nominate anyone else.

The board then discussed on whether or not the boys' team and girls' team representatives/coordinators should be board positions. Rhonda asked if anyone thought that there should be any other board positions. The board came to the conclusion that there should be a Team Parent who would have to come to all of the board meetings, has to be someone trustworthy and can handle money. The President opened the nominations for Team Parent. Scarlett Gettel was nominated by Lisa Souders and seconded by Angie Barmont to be the Team Parent. Scarlett accepted.

It was approved to re-elect all of the current board members by unanimous decision on a motion made by Jen Clough and seconded by Lisa Souders. Motion carries.

- Fair Stand Recommendations - Rhonda reported the following:
  - She is getting quotes for new doors (to replace the doors at the back of the stands and to put doors in at the seating/serving areas. The measurements have to be taken first.
  - She wants the floors to get painted
  - She wants to concrete the back patio. We have volunteers for the manpower to remove the pavers currently there.
  - After the estimates come in she would like to send out letters to raise the money needed for these projects.
  - She would like to re-do the lighting and get the sinks looked at since they do not hold water.
  - She would like to get new mats and a new refrigerator. Angie suggested approaching Squires for a new refrigerator.
  - Rhonda suggested selling the two large freezers that we no longer need.
- Restaurant Fundraiser: Joette reported that her goal is to have one restaurant fundraiser per month.
- Amazon Smile & Goodsearch: Adele reported that we cannot participate with Amazon Smile because the funds would go to the school. We are now registered with Goodsearch and Goodshop. Money is easily raised for the Booster Club if people set their internet search engine to Goodsearch and designate the cause to the Shippensburg Soccer Booster Club. After that is set, simply change your internet options to always open to that page when you search the internet. Everytime you search the internet it raises money. You can also use Goodshop to do your online shopping and a percentage of the purchases from participating online stores will go to the cause selected. There is also an app for Goodshop.

- Year in Review:
  - Rhonda thinks we should do more for the seniors and we should promote senior night more publicly for the varsity players.
  - We should get the soccer teams to participate in the Halloween and Homecoming parades.
  - We need to re-think the concept of the senior night awards.
  - There will be 9 senior boys next season and 6 senior girls.
  - The banquet food was very good.
  - Joette stated that cooking the meat prior the fair was wonderful.
  - Lisa stated that she thought this year's fair went much better than in years prior.
