

Shippensburg Soccer Booster Club

Meeting Minutes
September 12, 2016

In Attendance: Rhonda Gladfelter, Joette Shetter, Kim Taylor, Adele Kirby, Holly Newell, Sandra Pearson, Jennifer Clough, Scarlet Gettel, and Marc Hagemeyer..

The meeting was called to order at 7:01 PM by President Rhonda Gladfelter.

The August meeting minutes were approved on a motion made by Kim Taylor and seconded by Holly Newell. Motion carries.

The Treasurer's Report was presented and approved on a motion made by Scarlet Gettel and seconded by Sandra Pearson. Motion carries.

New Items:

- Parking Fundraiser: Rhonda reported that we were approached by the physical therapy place across from Memorial Park to do a parking fundraiser during the football games. We would charge \$3.00 per car to park in their parking lot. We have to have volunteers come on the nights of the home games to work. We would have to be set up by 5:00 pm. The gates to the game open between 5:30 and 6:00. We would take cars until the parking lot is full or until 7:00, whichever comes first. We would need no more than four volunteers per night. Matt & JoAnne Negley are taking this Friday, September 16th. There are four upcoming home games: 9/16, 9/23, 10/7 and 10/28 . We also need a sign made.
- Photographs: Parents were not happy with the pictures that Strawbridge took of the team this year. Stacy Lawson told Rhonda that she would like to take some different pictures. We need to check how much she would charge.

Old Items:

- Spirit Wear: The spirit wear has come in. Jen Van Horne is trying to get them delivered to the players that placed orders. We ordered additional spirit wear to sell at home games. It was also suggested to send the spirit wear info to the middle school players. We can set up tables at the home games to sell the spirit wear. We will need girls parents to sell at home games and boys parents to sell at girls games.
- Shed: Rhonda last heard that the new shed is in. Montedoro apparently ordered it by himself. We have no idea where he purchased it from or how much it cost. Montedoro said that he is waiting on Troy Mills to lay the stone before the shed is placed. Rhonda stated the we are not paying for the shed until Coach Jones approves. Rhonda has not

heard from the middle school field hockey team to see if they were still interested in sharing the shed. Rhonda also needs to figure out who will need keys to the shed.

- Youth Night: For the upcoming youth night we want to advertise that any Shippensburg Soccer Club or AYSO player who wears their jersey to our home games will get in for free. We just have to let Jan Nye know. Rhonda will email her. The parents will still have to pay to get in. The coaches of those teams can get in for free. We can get a list of the coaches names. Kim Taylor stated that she will donate items to give away as a raffle for the kids.
- Senior Nights:
 - Rhonda reported that Jan Nye and Montedoro picked the dates for senior night. The girls' senior night will be Tuesday October 11th at Memorial Park. The boys' senior night will be Thursday October 13th at Memorial Park. Student Council takes care of the announcements and provides the flowers with pins. Austin Taylor will announce the boys and Mrs. Minnich will find someone to announce the girls.
 - Senior Supper: Rhonda suggested doing a senior supper for all senior players and their parents. This would be held at the high school cafeteria and we would try to get all of the food donated. She is looking at having it on October 12th. Rhonda will check with the coaches to see if they are okay with it. The cafeteria needs to be reserved and eating would start at 6:30.
 - We also need to get the awards made for senior night.
 - We will need to have board members present at both senior night games.
- High School Banquet: This year's banquet will again be held at Premiere Events. It will be held on Tuesday, November 1st. The board decided on the following menu:
 - Meat: Glazed ham and stuffed chicken breast
 - Pasta: Baked macaroni & cheese
 - Hot Vegetable: Green beans almondine
 - Salad: Tossed salad
 - Hot Side: Mashed potatoes & gravyThe price is \$15.00 per person plus sales tax and gratuity. The club pays for the players. It was decided on a motion made by Joette Shetter and seconded by Holly Newell to charge the parents \$16.00 each. Marc Hagemeyer stated that he would like to have baby pictures of the seniors given to him by October 13th. Pictures can be given to him at the senior supper or emailed to him at mhagemeyer@aol.com.
- October Breast Cancer Awareness: Rhonda needs to follow up with Lisa Souders. Kim Taylor reported that she ordered 100 pairs of pink soccer laces last year. She has 40 pairs left. It is \$10 to \$11 to order more laces. We are looking at selling pink candy roses to

raise funds to donate to Breast Cancer Awareness. Holly Newell asked about selling t-shirts. Kim will look into this and will do a flyer beforehand. We can also take pre-orders.

- Restaurant Fundraisers: Joette Shetter reported that she is working on dates and places for the restaurant fundraisers. It is all in the works.
- Amazon Smile & Goodsearch: Adele Kirby reported that we cannot get enrolled with Amazon Smile because we are not our own separate 501(c)(3) charity. The umbrella we fall under is already set up with Amazon Smile and the money goes to them, not us. She already enrolled with Goodsearch and should hear back in a few days. Once it is approved the information will be sent out.
- Adele reported that at the executive meeting held on September 1, 2016 that it was approved to purchase new coolers on a motion made by Kim Taylor and seconded by Rhonda Gladfelter. It was also approved to pay Bob Baer \$15 per away game to keep the stats on a motion made by Joette Shetter and seconded by Adele Kirby. Rhonda reported that she offered to pay for a stat keeper for the girls' games but Mary Miller declined.
- Rhonda reported that she is sending out a food sign up sheet for this Saturday's tournament.
- Rhonda reported that she has started working on the fair stand recommendations.
 - She is trying to get two doors donated
 - They took measurements for the concrete for the back patio. Holly Newell can check on an estimate for the concrete with her brother who has his own concrete business.
 - Rhonda is in the process of pricing or getting doors donated for the serving sides of the fair stands.
 - We may have to look at purchasing a new refrigerator if we cannot get one donated.

Coaches Update: There are no updates from coaches since none are present at this meeting.
